

Training Opportunity for Emerging Entrepreneurs

The Basic Entrepreneurial Skills Development (BESD) programme is an initiative to promote business skills training for emerging entrepreneurs in the informal sector.

APPLY to be trained for fifteen (15) months period by an Entrepreneurial Development Practitioner (EDP) AT YOUR OWN BUSINESS PREMISES through one –on –one coaching process.

Selection Criteria/Requirements for EEs

- At least 6 months in operation
- Operating informally
- South African citizen with a 13-digit, bar-coded SA ID number.
- Can speak, read and write in English or local vernacular
- Operating within the specified area
- Willing to enter into a Coaching Agreement with the Training Provider
- Duration of coaching = period of 15 months
- Preference will be given to EE with 5 or less employees.

The BESD training/coaching DOES NOT provide access to credit, subsidies or funding from Seda or any other institution.
